

## **Visitor Screening Questions**

## ALL VISITORS AND PATIENTS MUST ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS -

- 1. Are you awaiting a COVID-19 test result?
- 2. Are you unwell with symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) such as a cough, sore throat, runny nose, stuffy nose, diarrhoea, shortness of breath, headache, nausea, vomiting, fever or loss of sense of taste or smell?
- 3. Have you visited any of the listed exposure sites in Victoria or interstate?
- 4. Have you arrived in Australia within the last 14 days?
- 5. Have you had known contact in the past 14 days with a person who was a confirmed COVID-19 case?
- 6. Have you been told to isolate or guarantine for 14 days?
- 7. Have you visited a Tier 1 exposure site and been advised to immediately isolate, get a COVID-19 test, and remain isolated for 14 days?
  - IF YOU ANSWER <u>YES</u> TO ANY QUESTIONS FROM 1 TO 7 => you <u>cannot</u> proceed any further and should go have a COVID-19 test (unless you have an exemption).
- 8. If you have been in isolation after visiting a Tier 2 exposure site have you received a negative COVID-19 test result?
- 9. Have you been given clearance by DHHS from self-isolation or quarantine following a diagnosis of COVID-19?
  - IF YOU ANSWER <u>NO</u> TO EITHER QUESTION 8 OR 9 => you <u>cannot</u> proceed any further and should go have a COVID-19 test (unless you have an exemption).

## **IMPORTANT NOTE – FACE MASKS**

## Face masks covering the mouth and nose MUST be worn at all times.

This is a very clear directive by the Victorian Government based on the advice of the Chief Health Officer – THIS IS MANDATORY unless you have an exemption.

(This is in line with the COVID Response Guide and directions from the Department of Health).
